### AGAPE FOOD AND GIFT REQUEST

***Agape food, 2 liter drinks and bottled water are needed for all of the upcoming walks. Please consider bringing fruits, trail mix, or something other than sweets.***

*Items may be dropped off at the Woods during set-up on Wednesday night prior to the walk or brought to send-off on Thursday evening. Agape items are welcome anytime throughout the weekend (the earlier the better).*

Also, agape gifts are always welcome and enjoyed by all. Gifts are to be kept small enough to be put into "carry-home" bags and should be supplied in adequate quantities for all candidates to receive equally. As a guideline, 32 gifts are enough to be placed on Pilgrims' beds, 48 gifts can be placed on tables in the Conference room, and 68 gifts allow everyone to be included.

***Individual gifts to pilgrims SHOULD NOT be brought to the Woods, but should be presented after closing on Sunday.***

### DO YOU WANT TO WORK ON AN EMMAUS WALK?

***First***, you should send your name, address and phone number to the future Walk leaders well in advance of the Walk. Preparation for most walks will begin approximately 2 years before the actual weekend. Don't just tell the future walk leader, write it down.

***Second***, you should attend Emmaus gatherings and show up to help the Walks as they occur. The Walk leaders are encouraged to select the people who show an interest in the day-to-day operations of the local Emmaus community and are willing to attend those functions and serve. You will get to know other people in the community and you become familiar with these new friends as you attend meetings. The future Walk leaders have literally dozens of things that require their attention.

***Third***, and most important—it may not be your time to be a team member, many hours are spent in prayer for the Walk and God does prepare the team, just ask any of the past Walk leaders! I had several names of certain people that I knew would be on the team, this was before God revealed that it was His Walk and not mine. My choices were scattered and shattered by this reality. Not one on my list was able to be the nucleus of the best team ever assembled. God selects the team! If you don't believe this, then just wait until it's your time to lead a Walk.
